**Puna Snipe Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2011 Casablanca valley, Chile** €24.00

A super Chilean Sauvignon Blanc. Light and fresh citrus fruit flavours. Good as an aperitif or with fish & lighter meats

**Domaine de la Colombette Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Côteaux du Libron, France** €25.00

From Languedoc-Roussillon in southern France this is a crisp Sauvignon with plenty of apple fruit and acidity. Wonderfully easy-drinking style.

**Hooded Plover Semillon Chardonnay 2009 New South Wales, Australia** €26.00

With fruit sourced from small producers all over New South Wales this is a reminder of how good Semillon & Chardonnay can be together. Juicy & ripe with melon & peach flavours.

**Côtes du Rhône Blanc 2010 La Villasse, Cairanne, France** €27.00

From the Cairanne appellation in southern Rhône comes this wonderful aromatic & fresh wine with lovely fruit purity. Made in conjunction with Thierry Caymaris of Cave de Cairanne fame.

**Le Sirocco Chardonnay 2009 Domaine Sainte Rose, Languedoc, France** €27.50

Unoaked chardonnay giving pure flavours of tropical fruit with a creamy finish. The wine-makers Charles & Ruth Simpson have fashioned a lovely modern clean French chardonnay.

**Sauvignon de Touraine 2010 Domaine des Corbillières, Loire, France** €29.50

Excellent Sauvignon from the Loire with loads of crisp pink grapefruit flavours, great with mussels & oysters. A mini-Sancerre.

**Pinot Grigio, Cantina San Simone 2010 Friuli Venezia-Giulia, Italy** €29.50

For four generations the Brisotto family have produced this excellent Pinot Grigio which is dry, crisp and elegant with good balance of acidity .

**La Bascula Catalan Eagle Organic Garnacha Viognier 2010 Terra Alta, Spain** €29.50

A Decanter Silver medal winner this wine shows fabulous peachy fruit with refreshing acidity and a rich texture. A favourite of mine.

**Grüner Veltliner Kabinett 2010 Karl Steininger, Kamptal Valley, Austria** €31.00

This family run 25 hectare estate in the charming wine village of Langenlois produces this excellent dry and fresh wine with influences of green apples, grapefruit and lemon.

**Albariño Bodegas Castro Martin 2009 Valle de Salnés, Rías Baixas , Spain** €32.50

From the coolest region of the Rias Baixas Angela Martin makes this superb wine with a clear precise style, loads of peachy, pear-like fruit and lemon & mineral acidity

**Innocent Bystander Chardonnay 2010 Yarra Valley, Victoria, Australia** €32.50

Founded in 2004 by Phil Sexton of Devil's Lair fame and with Steve Flamsteed from Leeuwin Estate on board as head winemaker these wines have a quality that belies their price

<p><b>Chablis 2009 Domaine William Fèvre, France</b></p> <p>William Fèvre is one of Chablis' greatest wine domains. This wine is hand-harvested and aged in small stainless steel vats with 10% French oak. Classic Chablis, superb.</p>	<p><b>€45.00</b></p>

**Puna Snipe Reserva Cabernet Carmenère 2009 Colchagua valley, Chile** €24.00

The upgrading of this wine to Reserva is down to the greater quality level imposed in the sourcing of the fruit. Good structure and plenty of intense red & black fruits.

**Domaine de la Colombette Syrah Grenache 2010 Côteaux du Libron, France** €25.00

This blend of 50% Syrah and 50% Grenache produces a lovely cherry fruit wine with a touch of spice on the finish. A lighter styled red with plenty of juicy fruit.

**Redfin Shiraz 2008 South Australia** €26.00

This wine is a great example of what made Australian wines such a dominant force in Ireland in the past. Vibrant and fruit driven whilst over-delivering on quality.

**Pinot Noir 2009 Bouchard Aîné et Fils, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France** €26.00

With ageing taking place in French oak and stainless steel this wine has jammy fruits, herbs & spices on the nose and a black fruit, palate tinged with vanilla. Lovely light style, good finish.

**Salice Salentino 2010 Masseria Pietrosa, San Marzano, Apulia, Italy** €27.00

From Puglia in the south-west region of Italy and made from the Negroamaro grape this wine shows sweet plums and raisins on the palate with a pleasing touch of bitterness on the finish.

**Côtes du Rhône Cuvée Tradition 2009 Domaine Coste Chaude, France** €27.00

With so much variable quality 'Côtes du Rhône' on offer it is nice to be able to offer this stylish, great value version. Classic blend of grenache, syrah & carignan

**Le Mistral Merlot 2009 Domaine Sainte Rose, Languedoc, France** €27.50

This much maligned grape (think the movie Sideways), here produces a well balanced wine with good clean dark berry fruit, soft tannins and great length.

**Château Fayau Bordeaux Supérieur 2008 Cadillac, Bordeaux, France** €29.50

With a wine making tradition that dates back to 1711, the Médeville family purchased this estate in 1826 and produce this classic blend of Cabernet's Sauvignon & Franc and Merlot

**Chianti Collezione Speciale 2009 Da Vinci, Tuscany, Italy** €29.50

From the hills outside Empoli comes this well priced and extremely well made Chianti which often outshines similarly-priced, and some more expensive, wines from other producers.

**Valpolicella 2010 Allegrini, Fumane di Valpolicella, Italy** €29.50

Allegrini are amongst the elite of the world's best wine producers. They have sacrificed the "classico" status of this wine to bottle the wine under stelvino to eliminate possible cork taint.

**Rioja Reserva 2006 Martinez Bujanda, Spain** €32.50

Classic Reserva Rioja from vineyards in the Alta & Alavesa regions. 100% Tempranillo and 20 months in American & French oak. Super, classy wine ideal with red meats

Paul & Isla Gordon; owners and winemakers here are from opposite sides of the world; Isla from Co. Carlow and Paul from Australia, their love of wine & each other produce this dark cherries & plums wine, excellent with red meat

**Malbec Reserva Finca Sopenia 2009 Gualtallary, Mendoza, Argentina** €34.00

Matias Michelini, aided by the 'guru-oenologist' Michel Rolland, produce this superb Malbec at 4000 feet in the foothills of the Andes. Complex, concentrated & classy.

**Bergerie de L'Hortus 2008 Côteaux du Languedoc, France** €34.00

One of Justin's favourites. "Domaine de l'Hortus produce some of the greatest wines of the Languedoc", John Wilson, Irish Times. Syrah, Mourvedre, Grenache. Dark, plummy, yummy.

**Château du Vieux Parc Cuvée Sélection 2007 Corbières, France** €35.00

For 5 generations the Panis family have been producing this blend of Syrah, Mourvèdre, Carignan & Grenache. Rich, elegant and perfectly balanced. One of Richard's favourites.

**Sherwood Estate Pinot Noir 2009 Waipara Valley, New Zealand** €37.50

Wonderful New Zealand Pinot. With 9 months in oak this wine displays lovely earthy, plum fruit balanced with refreshing acidity. Great length and style.

**Chinon Cuvée Terroir 2008 Domaine Charles Jouquet, Loire, France** €37.50

100 % Cabernet Franc. "Dark colour, intense fruity aromas and fine tannins are covering your palate, a blend of intensity and elegance" Charles Jouquet, winemaker.

**Château Montlisse 1998 Saint-Emilion Grand Cru** €37.50

Good mature colour with a cedar and red fruit nose. Long finish showing mature fruit and integrated oak and tannin character.

**Le Classique Syrah Grenache 2009 Domaine Joncier Lirac, Rhône, France** €39.50

This organic vineyard, run by the vivacious & feisty Marine Roussel produces true wines of the 'terroir'. Le Gourmand has lovely plum, kirsch & chocolate flavours with a layer of spice.

**La Grola 2008 Allegrini, Sant'Ambrogio di Valpolicella, Fumane, Italy** €49.50

The La Grola vineyard represents, in conjunction with an ancient legend that traces the birth of the Corvina varietal precisely to this magnificent hill, an ideal location for wine-making. Outstanding.

**Carmignano 2006 Capezzana di Carmignano** €52.50

Wine has been made at this property for 1200 years. This blend of 80% Sangiovese and 20% Cabernet produces an elegant, refined wine with great balance, structure & finish. Oh, and the villa pool is nice too!

**Gigondas 'les Pallières' 2005 Vignobles Brunier, Rhône, France** €55.00

From the finest terroirs in the most northerly reaches of the appellation, this elegant wine is perfectly matured and showing a gorgeous style and finesse. Perfect now.

**Brunello di Montalcino 2005 Conti Costanti €77.50**

Grown at over 400m. above sea-level these wines are amongst the best the region has to offer. The style of this Brunello is characterised by a striking elegance and intensity.

### Andrew Quady Elysium Black Muscat 2008 California, USA

The under-appreciated Black Muscat is a lowly table grape in Europe, Andrew Quady however creates a rose-scented luscious wine to accompany blue cheese, red fruit desserts and chocolate.

### Chateau Roumieu, Sauternes 2004 France,

The Semillon & Sauvignon Blanc grapes are picked one-by-one in stages when each grape has attained the required level of botrytisation. Long sweet floral finish, excellent.

### Forrest Estate, Botrytised Riesling 2005 Marlborough New Zealand

'Botrytis' is a benevolent form of fungus also known as 'Noble Rot' This occurs when ripe grapes are exposed to dry conditions and become raisin like. They can produce superb sweet wines like this.
